1) More activities for kids –

At the moment, there are not a lot of activities available to the children of Newhaven. Currently there is a Chill & Chat Group held on a Tuesday afternoon, in Newhaven Town Centre. This could be expanded to include more activities, on lot more days of the week. The Group and other activities available need to be advertised a lot more, in order to make kids more interested. 2) Careers open days with local businesses & the community services –
