RSD0040/25 TO RECEIVE A PRESENTATION FROM GUY McQUEEN REGARDING THE NEWHAVEN - COMBINED TOWN CENTRE STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS - STAGE 3 REPORT.

Mr. McQueen made a comprehensive presentation regarding the Town Transport Interchange and the High Street developments, their progress to date and key milestones in project delivery.

RSD0042/25 NEWHAVEN HIGH STREET MARKET – DISCUSSION ITEM (CLLR. S. BONIFACE).

Discussion took place regarding the casual ‘market’ that took place in the High Street on certain days of the week, and that it had been established that permissions from Lewes District Council already existed which were administered by the Newhaven Chamber of Commerce.

The Committee felt that more could be done to facilitate and improve its existing provision and operation, and unanimously,

RESOLVED that the Town Clerk contact relevant members within the Chamber of Commerce to take this forward.

RSD0043/25 LOCAL GOVERNMENT REORGANISATION – DISCUSSION ITEM

The Town Clerk reminded the Committee of the potential outcomes of the election of a Sussex Mayor, the re-organisation of Local Government within Sussex and the devolution or otherwise of legislative powers and services to Town and Parish Councils.

The Town Clerk suggested a range of considerations and potential outcomes from the above and requested that Committee Members begin the process of considering what objectives and level of ‘control’ the Town Council may like to achieve regarding the same.
